

POSTEL FAMILY CREDIT UNION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Postel Family Credit Union's Scholarship Program is intended to serve as motivation to eligible applicants who plan to attend Trade School, Technical School, Junior College, or University in the coming summer or fall semester.

The Credit Union will award (4) scholarships valued at \$500.00 each upon proof of enrollment into a qualified school.

The Scholarship Committee will consist of (3) three Board Members and (1) one credit union employee. APPLICATIONS MUST BE IN THE OFFICE NO LATER THAN JUNE 6, 2008. All applicants will be notified in writing of the decision made by the Scholarship Committee by JULY 6, 2008. Applications received will be used only by the Credit Union Scholarship Committee to select students for scholarship awards.

Decisions will be made from this application in accordance with financial need, community involvement and scholastic achievement.

Eligibility requirements

The SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT MUST be a member of Postel Family Credit Union and enrolled or plan to enroll as a full time student at a university, junior college, or trade school, in the year following high school graduation or you have received a Credit Union scholarship in the previous year.

Only scholarship applications received by the close of business JUNE 6, 2008, will be considered.

An application must be submitted EACH year to be considered for a scholarship. All questions need to be answered and all blanks filled in. No scholarship will be automatically renewed.

No student or prospective student will be excluded from participation in or be denied the benefits of a scholarship on the basis of race, color, age, religion, national origin or sex.

RECIPIENTS MUST MEET ALL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS.

A COMPLETED APPLICATION CONSISTS OF:

- **Completed 2 page application**
- **A copy of your transcript(s) showing your last four years academic record.**
- **An academic letter of recommendation from your school principal, counselor or advisor.**
- **A personal letter of recommendation from a responsible person in your community who knows you well and can attest to your personal qualities and abilities. This letter MUST NOT be written by a family member or casual acquaintance.**
